Dear friends and family of Plymouth!

First, an update on the building: the current design of the floor plan and 3D model of the building are on display in the chapel. Please take a look at them if you haven't seen them yet. Some parts of the design may need to be changed depending on results of the topological survey, the needs of ductwork and plumbing, and mechanical systems, but we should end up with something very close to the current design. The floorplan and its placement on the property is

welcoming and inspiring, the usable space has been maximized, and it has good flow within the structure, all of which will help us better minister to and with our community. The new kitchen is about 40% larger than the old, too, and the Women of Plymouth will be meeting with the architects to design it to best meet the needs of how we will use it.

We are not yet to the point of discussing colors, materials, outside siding, furniture, and so forth, but we are a couple steps further ahead than we were a month ago and that is a good feeling!

Second, as you may remember from previous Pastor's Pens, a number of UCC churches had fires last year. The pastor of one of those churches, Rev. Tim Devine of St. Paul's UCC in Seattle, is doing a sabbatical project this summer to visit the churches that had fires. He will worship with us on June 25, and he would like you all to stay after worship for an hour or so to talk about your experiences since the fire.
