Financial Reports:

As of October 31, 2025 Year to Date Income \$108,603.95 Year to Date Expenses \$113,239.53 Ahead (Behind) (\$7,677.30)

Treasurer's Report:

Year to date envelope income is \$77,566, \$7,369 less than last year at this point, but \$16,992 more than the YTD average going back to 2009. Expenses include a quarterly payment on building insurance and workers comp installment. Funds received through September 30, 2025 for OCWM and Community Table were disbursed.

Memorial Fund Balance: \$9,285.56 **Reserve Fund Balance:** \$9,070.95

Financial reports were reviewed and accepted.
